## **EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021-01**

WHEREAS, the safety and welfare of the citizens of Morgan City is of utmost concern of the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, Morgan City Council has received information along with a request from the Fire Chief in regards to fire hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Utah Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands has issued fire restrictions for the State of Utah.

**THEREFORE,** by the authority vested in me as the Mayor by state statute and by a motion of the Morgan City Council, I hereby issue this EXECUTIVE ORDER establishing fire restrictions for the incorporated area of Morgan City as follows:

## **FIRE RESTRICTIONS**

- 1. No open fires of any kind except within established facilities in improved campgrounds or day-use areas on public lands. -OR- In permanently constructed fire pits at permanent private dwellings served by pressurized running water.
- 2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet (3') in diameter that is barren or cleared to mineral soil.
- 3. Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition or other pyrotechnic devices including explosive targets.
- 4. Cutting, welding, or grinding metal in areas of dry vegetation.
- 5. Operating a motorcycle, chainsaw, ATV, or other small internal combustion engine without an approved and working spark arrestor.

The following persons are exempted from the above prohibitions:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act at a specific location.
- 2. Any State or Federal Fire Officer or firefighting forces in the performance of an official duty.

## AREA COVERED AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This EXECUTIVE ORDER shall take effect June 22, 2021, at 12:00 midnight and shall continue in effect until further notification. This EXECUTIVE ORDER shall cover the following areas: (See attached map.)

North of 600 East and 700 East to City Boundary; and

East and South of Imperial Drive, including the South Morgan Cemetery to the City Boundary; and

200' on either side of Weber River bottoms.
